Notes: Getting Sickness Out of Your Mind Pt. 4:

Are you dealing with a divided heart/mind?

Have you had this experience:

Mike:

Saying one thing with your mouth but having your

heart(mind) in a completely different place?

That's important for you to understand because you may be like with me - I was like:

"Yes, I know in the Name of Jesus I'll be healed."

That's the knowledge I had (from listening/reading about healing).

But when that sickness(cancer) came to me, I allowed it into my mind.

I'm speaking in the name of Jesus but nothing's happening.

## Recap from Pt. 3:

Job: "It may be....." Job 1:5

"That which I greatly feared has come upon me." Job. 3:25&26

Prov. 14:12

There is a way that seems right unto a man(Job making continual sacrifices for his children in case they had sinned) but the ends thereof are the ways of death.

What is that saying?

That we might THINK in our MIND: "Oh, this is the right way to do it!" (Get healed) But if what you are thinking is the 'right way' is not the Truth

according to God's Word, the end result is going to be death (or you will get no results).

Let me just relate this personally....

You might be challenged with a sickness or a disease right now that you've been commanding and you've been rebuking and you've been speaking to and you've been quoting all the scriptures and you've been spending eight hours a day in the Word and you're wondering: "What is going on? I still have the symptoms."

36:39

A 'spiritual mechanic/tool':

Well folks, could it be that your heart is divided? That in your heart you're thinking: "I'm sick. I'm going to die." etc. etc.

But **outside** your mind (your spirit) is telling you the Truth that you know from God's Word: "No I don't have to put up with this!"

But yet deep down inside there's a division in your heart and you're still cooperating with the sickness and disease.

37:04

A good example of this is in James chapter 1: Inward Division This is where I was stuck.

Let's nail down this definition of inward division - you can't get rid of it if you don't know exactly how it operates in you.

In James chapter 1 it is talking about lacking wisdom and if you want more wisdom, it says just ask God. But James said you have to ask in faith nothing wavering:

Verse 6. Let him ask in faith nothing wavering, for he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed.

Get that picture in your mind. Is there calmness on the sea during a storm? No, not at all.

The waves are tossed to and fro. If you were to be out there on a boat you'd be up and down and up and down.

James is saying that's what happens when this occurs: Verse 7- a double-minded man is unstable in all of his ways. Verse 8 let not that man think that he shall receive anything of the Lord.

As long as your heart is divided between two decisions or opinions .....and you are not able to exercise steadfastness - (which is faith). And faith is how we receive what God has done for us in Christ.

So the only way that you're going to be able to get to this position of being steadfast in your heart and mind is to be single-minded

## Another item: What's in your heart in abundance?

If you're struggling with: "Yes, I'm well but I have these symptoms" - why is that?

It's because there's something else more abundant in your heart than the Truth that you were healed by the stripes of Jesus, Amen?

Consider this: in my mind and heart I was thinking that "Yes by Jesus stripes I was healed," but a more dominant thought was this: "There's something I need to do or stop doing in order for God to release the healing."

Simply put I was believing that my Deliverance was based on my performance.

But do you know the moment that I believed the Truth to the exclusion of any other variable, in other words, when I saw Jesus did everything: he healed me, forgave me of all sins. That not one thing I could do would improve upon that and in fact if I thought I needed to do one thing, I was saying Jesus didn't do enough!

So the moment that quickened to my heart(understanding/mind) do you know what happened?

I saw and realized that the lie that was keeping me bound was from Satan. That he was the one saying to me "You better do this. You better do that. You better offer a sacrifice. You better..." No different than Job.

42:45

So what happened when I realized the truth? I said: "No, I don't have to do anything. I am healed because Jesus did it all.

Do you know what happened?
That moment my mind reset and I said
"No, there's nothing I need to do",
and there was no more place for the devil.

My heart was no longer divided and you know what happened? I immediately began to recover.

43:16

That goes to the point that I made from the beginning: sickness and disease in the body is really no problem, it's what we have believed about it in our mind and our heart that keeps it there and until we break that lie, until we replace that lie with the Truth, what's going to be the case?

We're going to still be struggling, we're going to be a yo-yo. Down one minute up the next!

Down up, down up, down up.

We're going to be like a wave tossed to and fro.

But once our mind becomes single on that (I don't have to do anything. I am healed because Jesus did it all), what's going to be the end result? The end result is going to be freedom.

Go with me to Proverbs 3 verse 1: My son, forget not my law but let thine <u>heart</u> keep my Commandments, for **length of days, long life and peace** shall they add to thee. Let not Mercy And Truth forsake thee. Bind them about the neck. Write them on the 'table'/tablet of your heart.

What you think of cancer.

What you think of disease

What you think of this

What you think of that

# All that is being written on your heart.

The more times you hear it and

the more times you listen to what it's saying,

the more times you watch the news,

the more times you listen to the bad news,

that's giving opportunity to the enemy to write something on your heart/mind.

Unless you take thoughts captive they're going to be written on your heart and what's going to happen? You are going to get 'bad fruit'.

In Matthew 11 Jesus said: You can't get good fruit on a bad tree and you can't get bad fruit on a good tree, so out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks.

So if you have all these things written on your heart about what the world says and what the **natural mind** is telling you, then when you're challenged what's going to be the first thing that comes out?

It's going to be what's most written on the table of your heart.

The same phrase is used in Proverbs 7:1:

My son keep my words. Lay up my commandments with you.

Keep my commandments and live and my law as the apple of thine eye.

#### 47:10

What's he saying? He's saying: **Look at everything <u>through</u> what my Word says**,

not through what your experience has been or what the world is telling you. What your flesh or your symptoms are telling you.

But look at it through what my Word says.

### He says

Bind my Word and my Commandments and my Truths, bind them upon thy fingers and write them on the table of thine heart.

See you need to make that decision.

If you have written on your heart "by the stripes of Jesus I was healed" then what's going to happen when sickness knocks on your door?

You're going to go through the filing cabinet(MIND) and say "Oh, I'm already healed, so Satan you can't put that on me. Jesus bore that. I don't need to bear it. Get it out of here."

That'll be your reaction, okay, because you react out of the abundance of your heart amen

To find out what is in control and in abundance: examine your reactions.
