Instantaneous Healing Of The Nobleman's Son....

John 4:

6 So Jesus came again into Cana of Galilee, where he made the water wine. And there was a certain nobleman, whose son was sick at Capernaum. 47 When he heard that Jesus was come out of Judaea into Galilee, he went unto him, and besought him that he would come down, and heal his son: for **he was at the point of death.**

48 Then said Jesus unto him, Except ye see signs and wonders, ye will not believe.

(Voice: *My word is not enough*; you only believe when you see miraculous signs.

New Matthew Bible: Then Jesus said to him, Unless you see signs and wonders, you cannot believe.)

49 The nobleman saith unto him, Sir, come down ere my child die.

50 Jesus **saith** unto him, Go thy way; thy son liveth.

And the man **believed the word** that Jesus had spoken unto him, and he went his way.
(AMPC: he man put his trust in what Jesus said and started home)

TLB: Then Jesus told him, "Go back home. Your son is healed!" And the man believed Jesus and started home.

MSG: The man believed the bare word Jesus spoke and headed home.

NIVUK: The man took Jesus at his word

51 And as he was now going down, his servants met him, and told him, saying, Thy son liveth. 52 Then enquired he of them the hour when he began to amend. And they said unto him, **Yesterday at the seventh(1:00pm) hour** the fever left him.

53 So the father knew that it was at **the same hour**, in the which **Jesus said** unto him, Thy son liveth: and himself believed, and his whole house.

(AMP: it was at that very hour

Evangelical Heritage Version: the exact time

Phillips: On the journey back his servants met him with the report, "Your son is alive and well." So he asked them at what time he had begun to recover, and they replied: "The fever left him yesterday at one o'clock in the afternoon". Then the father knew that this must have happened at the very moment when Jesus had said to him, "Your son is alive and well."

New Testament for Everyone: it had happened at the very moment when Jesus had said to him, "Your son will live!"

Instantaneous Healing Of The Impotent Man @ the Pool of Bethesda

John 5

After this there was a feast of the Jews; and Jesus went up to Jerusalem.

2 Now there is at Jerusalem by the sheep market a pool, which is called in the Hebrew tongue Bethesda, having five porches. 3 In these lay a great multitude of impotent folk, of blind, halt, withered, waiting for the moving of the water.

4 For an angel went down at a certain season into the pool, and troubled the water: whosoever then first after the troubling of the water stepped in was made whole of whatsoever disease he had. 5 And a certain man was there, which had an infirmity thirty and eight years. 6 When Jesus saw him lie, and knew that he had been now a long time in that case, he saith unto him, **Wilt thou be made whole?**

7 The impotent man answered him, Sir, I have no man, when the water is troubled, to put me into the pool: but while I am coming, another steppeth down before me.

8 Jesus **saith** unto him, **Rise, take up thy bed, and walk.**

9 And immediately the man was made whole, and took up his bed, and walked

My Father is A Healer so I heal as I see my Father do:

17 But Jesus answered them, **My Father worketh hitherto, and I work.**

19 Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, **The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do:** for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.

Instantaneous Multiplication of Loaves & Fishes

John 6

1 After these things Jesus went over the sea of Galilee, which is the sea of Tiberias.

5 When Jesus then lifted up his eyes, and saw **a great company** come unto him, he saith unto Philip, **Whence shall we buy bread, that these may eat?**

6 And this he said to prove him: for he himself knew what he would do.

7 Philip answered him, Two hundred pennyworth of bread is not sufficient for them, that every one of them may take a little. 8 One of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, saith unto him, 9 There is a lad here, which hath five barley loaves, and two small fishes: but what are they among so many? 10 And Jesus said, Make the men sit down. Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, in number about five thousand.

11 And Jesus took the loaves; and **when he had given thanks, he distributed** to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were set down; and likewise of the fishes **as much as they would.**

12 When they were filled, he said unto his disciples, **Gather up the fragments** that remain, that nothing be lost. 13 Therefore they gathered them together, and **filled twelve baskets with the fragments** of the five barley loaves, which remained over and above unto them that had eaten.

Instantaneous Healing Of The Man Born Blind...again, healing is the Father's Work

John 9

1 And as Jesus passed by, he saw a man which was blind from his birth.

4 Jesus said: I must **work the works of him that sent me**, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work. 5 As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.

6 When he had thus spoken, he spat on the ground, and made clay of the spittle, and he anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay, 7 And **said** unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, (which is by interpretation, Sent.) He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing.

Instantaneous Resurrection of Lazarus:

John 11

11after that he saith unto them, Our friend Lazarus sleepeth; but I go, that I may awake him out of sleep. 12 Then said his disciples, Lord, if he sleep, he shall do well. 13 Howbeit Jesus spake of his death: but they thought that he had spoken of taking of rest in sleep. 14 Then said Jesus unto them plainly, Lazarus is dead. 15 And I am glad for your sakes that I was not there, to the intent ye may believe; nevertheless let us go unto him.

38 Jesus therefore again groaning in himself cometh to the grave. It was a cave, and a stone lay upon it. 39 Jesus said, Take ye away the stone. Martha, the sister of him that was dead, saith unto him, Lord, by this time he stinketh: for he hath been dead four days. 40 Jesus saith unto her, Said I not unto thee, that, if thou wouldest believe, thou shouldest see the glory of God? 41 Then they took away the stone from the place where the dead was laid. And Jesus lifted up his eyes, and **said**, Father, I thank thee that thou hast heard me. 42 And I knew that thou hearest me always: but because of the people which stand by I said it, that they may believe that thou hast sent me. 43 And when he thus had spoken, he **cried with a loud voice**, Lazarus, come forth. 44 And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go.

The Instantaneous Healing Of The High Priest's Servant's Ear

John 18

10 Then Simon Peter having a sword drew it, and smote the high priest's servant, and cut off his right ear. The servant's name was Malchus.

Luke 22

48 But Jesus said unto him, Judas, betrayest thou the Son of man with a kiss?

49 When they which were about him saw what would follow, they said unto him, Lord, shall we smite with the sword? 50 And one of them smote the servant of the high priest, and cut off his right ear.

51 And Jesus answered and said, Suffer ye thus far. And he **touched** his ear, and healed him.
